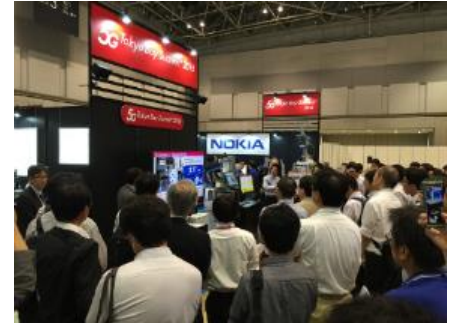


About WTP International Day
